LADIES – IF YOU ORDERED A NEW DRESS, IT IS HERE – PLEASE PICK UP BEFORE REHEARSAL IN GRAHAM LOUNGE. If you have not yet paid, please do so before picking up your dress, thank you!

Concert Attire: Women- required black dress, black, close-toed shoes, black hose. No neckware. Small post or single drop earrings. No flashy or large jewelry or hairwear. **Men-** black tux (regular jacket, not tails), black bow tie, studs & links, black cummerbund (no vests); black dress shoes, black socks, white, wing-collar shirt. **Everyone-** No perfume, smelly hair product, cologne; Yes shower, deodorant! **DO NOT WEAR CONCERT ATTIRE TO DRESS REHEARSALS!**
